Range Rules and Conditions of Membership

1. Membership to Alders Farm Gun Range is open to anyone at the discretion of Alders Farm Enterprises Ltd, provided that they are legally permitted to possess, use or own an airgun. And that they agree to accept and conform to the rules and safety code and pay such fees as are required.
2. It is the responsibility of the person making the booking to ensure that each person in their group is aware of the terms, conditions & rules.
3. If you have been to prison, youth custody or a young offender's institution you could be prohibited under Section 21 of the fire arms act to use or possess a firearm or ammunition, including air guns.
4. All Members to sign in and pay before use of range
5. The Indoor and Outdoor range are only available during shop opening hours.
6. Only 2 people per lane at anytime
7. You must be 18 years or over to use the range unaccompanied. Children and young people are actively encouraged to participate, however it is the responsibility of a parent or guardian (over 21 years of age) to control the safety & behaviour of the child or young person in their care at all times. Adult to child ratio is strictly - 1 Adult (21 or over) to 1 minor (under the age of 18) this has to be direct supervision under 14
8. 14-18 year olds have to be accompanied by parent/guardian (21 or over) however can be indirect on the adjacent lane.
9. Safety is the responsibility of all participants.
10. Only 1 gun to be allowed in a lane at any one time.
11. Always assume that all guns are loaded & therefore dangerous.
12. Never point a gun at another person.
13. Never leave a gun unsupervised.
14. When on the range guns must be kept in a case, slip or bag at all times when not in use.
15. Guns must be carried into shooting bays in a case, slip or bag.
16. Shooting bays are designated by wooden and metal structures and guns to be kept range side of the red line.
17. In the event of a gun being taken off the range it is the users responsibility to ensure that the gun is not loaded and that the magazine is removed or the barrel is broken.
18. Never enter the range target/firing area, always ask a member of staff for assistance.
19. If a Range Officer calls a cease Fire, verbally or by one blast of the whistle, all members must make the gun safe and step away from their gun. The member must not touch the gun again until the Range officer has made it clear it is safe to do so, verbally or 2 blasts of the whistle.
20. Never shoot higher than the RED indication line at the end of the range.
21. A blast of a whistle by the Range Control Officer is the instruction to make all guns safe and step back from the shooting area to allow the range officer to give instructions.
22. 2 blasts of the whistle by the Range Control Officer indicates it is safe to return to your gun and firing may commence.
23. Never shoot at anything other than targets, for example: props, lights, walls, ceiling, beams, and general fixtures & fittings. Outdoors strictly no shooting at Trees, fence posts and especially animals.



24. Lead, Tin and plastic Pellets only - No BB's to be used at Alders Farm Gun Range
25. Any behaviour that would be deemed as disruptive and/or offensive, which adversely affects or offends other range users, either directly or indirectly will not be tolerated and you will be asked to leave the premises.
26. Anyone under the influence of controlled substances eg, drugs or alcohol will be asked to leave the premises.
27. It is the person using the range to inform the Range Control Officer that day immediately of any incidents that have occurred during their visit
28. Own guns must be in sound working order.
29. No Member should touch another member's gun(s), equipment or possessions without first obtaining the owner's permission.
30. All members shall make themselves aware of the laws relating to the safe use and responsibilities of ownership of airguns and the penalties for their misuse.
31. An Air cylinder will be provided for the outdoor range for members to refill their PCP Airguns, but this can only be used if the member has first had a filling briefing from a member of staff (signed document). Shooters must ensure that they make their gun safe. PCP Pistols and Rifles must be carried pointing downwards when going to and from the refill point.
32. All Users of the Air Cylinder must have own filling probe with quick release fitting.
33. Rifles exceeding 12ftlb, Pistols exceeding 6ftlb muzzle energy are not permitted. Under the fire arms act it is the responsibility of the gun owner to insure that their air rifle is within the legal 12ftlb limit and air pistols are within 6ftlb limit. We reserve the right at any time to chrono test any gun and if it is found to be over the legal limit it will be retained by Alders Farm Enterprises Ltd until the correct licence can be produced. If a licence cannot be produced we will inform the police.
34. When Using the Outdoor Range all guns must have a sound moderator fitted (silencer).
35. No Exploding Targets to be used on both indoor and outdoor range.
36. As a member we encourage you to be observant and please report anything you see or hear that you are uncomfortable with and or rules are not be being adhered to.
37. Vehicles are parked at owners risk on site at Alders Farm
